

# User's Guide to suftesi\*

## A document class for typesetting theses, books and articles

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### Abstract

The `suftesi` class provides a set of page layouts, title styles and heading styles for typesetting theses, books and articles. It is based on the standard `book` class and inspired by the works of Bringhurst (1996), Tschichold (1975) and Morison (1936). See the template file `tesi.tex` in the `example` folder.

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## Note on copyright

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In addition to the terms of this license the author requires an attribution notice like the following one:

*This work has been typeset with L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X, using the suftesi class by Ivan Valbusa.*<sup>2</sup>

The most important feature of this class is the set of styles it provides. For this reason:

**DO NOT MODIFY THE STYLES OF THIS CLASS  
IF YOU DO NOT LIKE THESE STYLES, USE ANOTHER CLASS.**

If you use `suftesi` in a document typeset with another class (for example `book`), remember to clean up the preamble from all the layout redefinitions.

## Loaded packages

The class loads the following packages: `beramono`, `calc`, `caption`, `color`, `enumitem`, `emptypage`, `epigraph`, `fancyhdr`, `fontenc`, `geometry`, `ifluatex`, `ifxetex`, `iwona`, `mathpazo`, `microtype`, `mparhack`, `multicol`, `textcase`, `titlesec`, `titletoc`.

# 1 Class features

## 1.1 Layout

The standard document classes allow you to typeset beautiful documents but their layout is quite far from the stylistic requests of some humanists (especially italian). The styles provided by `suftesi` are very simple and sober, and also have the aim of finding in the formal simplicity an aesthetic harmony. They are largely inspired by some beautiful readings, particularly Bringhurst (1996), Tschichold (1975) and Morison (1936). Table 1 summarizes the main features of the styles provided by `suftesi`.

## 1.2 Font

The default font for body text is Palatino designed by Hermann Zapf.<sup>3</sup> The sans serif font is Iwona designed by Janusz M. Nowacki. This choice is inspired by *L'arte di scrivere con L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X* (Pantieri and Gordini 2011).

### 1.2.1 Using different fonts

If you prefer to use other fonts (such as those provided by `fourier`, `lmodern` or `libertine` packages), remember to load the class option `defaultfont`, which turns off the `suftesi` font settings. Moreover pay particular attention in choosing the greek font.

### 1.2.2 Greek alphabet

The default font for the greek text is Artemisia by the Greek Font Society, which is very suitable for Palatino:

Alla Natura che ogni cosa dona e ogni cosa riprende ... Πρέπει να  
σκεφτούμε μια συναρτηση της οποιας γνωρίζουμε ότι υπαρχει το ολο-  
κληρωμα.

With the `porson` option you can use the Porson font by the Greek Font Society:

The default `greek` option allows you to use the standard CB Greek font:<sup>4</sup>

### 1.3 Frontispiece

The class has a original frontispiece now directly available loading the `frontespizio` package (Gregorio 2009)<sup>5</sup> with the `suftesi` option (see the template file `tesi.tex` in the `example` folder):

## 2 Options

In addition to the options defined by the book document class, `suftesi` accepts the following new options.

### 2.1 Page layout

<code>dottedtoc</code>	Prints a standard table of contents with dotted lines.
<code>raggedtoc</code>	Aligns the table of contents on the left as Bringhurst (1996) suggests.
<code>compact</code>	Prints a typeblock of 16cm × 24cm on a A4 paper, showing the crop marks (see table 1 for details). The <code>\crop[off]</code> command turns off the crop marks.
<code>supercompact</code>	The same as <code>compact</code> but with a typeblock of 14cm × 21cm (see table 1 for details).
<code>periodical</code>	The same as <code>compact</code> but with a typeblock of 17cm × 24cm (see table 1 for details). This style is expecially thought for theses.
<code>elements</code>	Reproduces the layout of <i>The Elements of Typographyc Style</i> by Robert Bringhurst (see table 1 for details).
<code>nocrop</code>	Prints a PDF with page dimensions according to the <code>compact</code> , <code>supercompact</code> and <code>elements</code> options.
<code>nomarginpar</code>	Disables the <code>\marginpar</code> command. This option is useful for the three “compact” layouts.
<code>11pt</code>	Sets the font size at 11pt and resizes the text block dimensions.

## 2.2 Titles and headings

<code>sctitles</code>	Prints the headings and the chapter (section) titles in small caps.
<code>centertitle</code>	Centers the chapter title and number, with the chapter title below the number.
<code>sufelements</code>	Loads the <code>sctitles</code> class option and prints the chapter numbers according to the <code>elements</code> option.
<code>centerheadings</code>	Prints the page number in the center of the footer, the string “Chapter <i>n</i> ” in the header of even pages and the chapter title in the header of odd pages.
<code>sufplain</code>	Prints no headers and puts the page number in the center of the footer.
<code>authortitle</code>	Changes the content of the headings. It prints the author’s name on the even numbered pages and the title on the odd ones. This option can be combined with the other options seen above. In order to use this option the <code>\title</code> and <code>\author</code> commands are required.
<code>article</code>	This option is aimed to typeset articles or short theses (that is to say without chapter divisions) in a two side document.
<code>bozza</code>	Prints the following note in the footer:  Version of <i>&lt;date&gt;</i>
<code>plain</code>	An older name of the <code>centerheadings</code> option. Disabled since version 0.6.
<code>fullplain</code>	An older name of the <code>sufplain</code> option. Disabled since version 0.6.

## 2.3 Fonts

<code>artemisla</code>	Loads the Artemisia font (default).
<code>porson</code>	Loads the Porson font.
<code>defaultgreek</code>	Loads the standard CB Greek font.
<code>defaultfont</code>	Loads the $\TeX$ standard font and set the <code>\baselineskip</code> to the standard default.
<code>disablefront</code>	Disabled since version 0.5.

## 3 Commands

The class defines the following new commands.

`\title[<short title for headings>]{<complete title for titlepage>}`

This command is for use with option `authortitle` if the title is too long or has some breaks.

`\colophon[<OS>]{<name and surname>}{<additional info>}`

This command is provided only for italian documents. It prints a page with a copyright notice and the colophon in the bottom. For different languages use the `\bookcolophon` instead (see below).

If you don’t like the copyright notice leave the second argument of the command empty:

`\colophon[<OS>]{ }{<additional info>}`

With the article option, you can use the `\artcolophon` command (see below) or the `\thanks` command:

`\bookcolophon{<copyright notice>}{<attribution notice and other informations>}`

This command is similar to `\colophon` but it is completely customizable. The first argument prints its content (usually the copyright notice) in the center of the page. The second argument prints its content at the bottom. For example:

`\artcolophon{<copyright notice, attribution and other informations>}`

This command has only one argument. It simply prints its content at the bottom of the page. Here is an example:

`\finalcolophon{<colophon content>}`

The same as `\artcolophon`, but centering its content at the top of the page. It is aimed to typeset a classical *colophon* at the end of the work.

`\chapterintro`

Prints an unnumbered introduction at the beginning of the chapters, with the correct hyperlink. In order to use this command the `hyperref` package must be loaded.

`\chapterintroname{<name>}` (default=Introduzione)

Changes in `<name>` the title printed by the `\chapterintro` command.

`\appendicesname{<name>}` (default=Appendici)

Changes in `<name>` the title printed by the `\appendix` command.

`\headbreak`

A manual break which is active for the table of contents but not in the text or in the headings

`\xheadbreak`

A manual break which is active in the text and in the headings but not in the table of contents.

`\chapnumfont{<name>}`

Sets the font for the chapter number with the `sufelements` option. The default is “`ptlj`” ( $\TeX$ ) or “`Palatino`” ( $\XeTeX$ ).
